It is expected that WWU Graduates will work towards Professional Qualifications and become a professionally registered engineer (Chartered status).</p> <p>Based at our head office in Newport, our two-year Graduate Development Programme includes formal training and mentoring from experienced engineers and managers and focuses on the achievement of Chartered Engineer status and is accredited by both the Institute of Gas Engineers and Managers, the Institute of Mechanical Engineers.</p> <p>WWU System based training during the chartership will include common business applications such as SAP, Microsoft Packages i.e. Word, Excel, PowerPoint and other APP based products.</p>
