Purpose & Overview	<p>To support in the delivery of the Net Zero strategy within WWU. The role will provide project management support to the wider UK Hydrogen Blending Implementation programme and support industrial decarbonisation projects providing key stakeholder management responsibilities, providing support to the Net Zero Portfolio Manager and in turn the Hydrogen Transformation Manager.</p> <p>This will require project management activities focusing on hydrogen blending implementation programme delivery and building on existing work to manage stakeholder input interactions on the extensive I&C portfolio. It will require close liaison with multiple internal stakeholders, attendance at external forums, the production of timely updates, internal and external communication, and collation and design of programmes of work specific to Net Zero and Business Evolution.</p>
Key Accountabilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend Hydrogen Blending Implementation Programme workshops and external forums with key organisations such as other GDN's and DESNZ. • Support both the WWU Business Evolution and Hydrogen teams to collate, co-ordinate and inform future programmes of work. • Liaise with a broad range of internal stakeholders to manage activities and report on outcomes of the Hydrogen Blending implementation programme. • Reporting of project progress and dissemination of key findings both internally and externally. • Engage key partners within existing industrial clusters such as Hydrogen South West to deliver WWU's strategic aims. • Own and manage relationships with hydrogen producers to understand opportunities for early grid-entry and/or private pipeline opportunities (incl. blending) • Develop and manage our database of industrial and commercial customers, using existing work to map information such as customer readiness, hydrogen demand and profiles • Support the co-development of early-mover hydrogen pipeline projects such as HyLine Cymru alongside
